

OUR GOAL

OhioMHAS is committed to helping individuals with mental illness and substance use disorders explore options for integrated community living, a goal achieved through programs like the Residential State Supplement (RSS) and Recovery Requires a Community. Community Integration initiatives facilitate change on a personal and policy level by providing statewide leadership, financial assistance, and empowering individuals to live and recover within their communities.

OUR PROGRAMS

RESIDENTIAL STATE SUPPLEMENT (RSS)

Provides financial and Medicaid assistance to adults with a disability to help with accomodations, supervision, and personal care services in eligible living arrangements, i.e. Class 2 Residential Facilities (RF2s).

Eligibility Criteria:

- Eligible for or enrolled in Medicaid
- Receiving Social Security, Supplemental Security Income (SSI), or Supplemental Security Disability Insurance (SSDI)
- Planning for discharge from a nursing home or need at least a Protective Level of Care
- Currently living in or planning to move to an RF2 licensed by OhioMHAS
- Have a monthly income up to \$1,800 and assets up to \$2,000

RECOVERY REQUIRES A COMMUNITY

Provides financial assistance to adults with a behavioral health diagnosis to transition from nursing homes to sustainable community living.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Enrolled in Medicaid
- Has a mental illness or substance use disorder
- Currently receiving treatment in a nursing home
 OR recently transitioned from a nursing home
- Has sufficient income or the means to sustain community living at the time of transition
- Has needs that can be safely met through the Recovery program or a combination of community resources
